Bartholomew, Wolfgang, Thomas and Christina arrived in Savannah, Georgia with a group of German Protestants (Lutherans) on October 23, 1751 aboard the English Ship "Antelope" with Captain John McClelland. They traveled as members of the 2nd Swabian Unit from Langenau by ULM, South Germany near the Austrian border.

There were three brothers and a sister who arrived in Georgia in 1751. They acquired land and settled in the Ebenezeer/Bethany Community (Salzburger) of Georgia, which is about 20 miles north of Savannah on the Savannah River which is now Effingham County, Georgia.

There seems to be a question of whether or not Wolfgang Mock was a brother to Bartholomew, Thomas and Christina. I have been unable to find any information to the contrary.

All four of this family of Mocks married and began raising families. Bartholomew, Wolfgang and Christina died after a short life and are buried in the Bethany Cemetery which is about 5 miles from the old Ebenezer Church and cemetery.

Thomas married Mary Weinkauf in 1765. They lived in the area called Blue Bluff until about 1771 when they moved to Mecklenburg ,Cabarrus Co.,N.C. with Mary's family. Thomas died in 1807 and is buried in Cold Water Lutheran Church Cemetery near Concord, N.C. Mary died in 1816 and is buried at Mt. Zion Cemetery at China Grove, N.C.

Thomas and Mary Weinkauff Mock are my 5th great grandparents on my father's side and 4th great grandparents on my mother's side. William George Mock married into my father's family and his sister, Christina married into my mother's family.

I hope this article and pedigree chart will be of interest to Mock researchers. I feel certain that my Mocks are connected with the group that entered the US through Pennsylvania and later united in North Carolina. Hopefully someone has the missing piece of the puzzle to connect the two families.

A lot of credit has to be given to George Mock of Bainbridge, GA, who did a great deal of research on this family before I became involved. An aunt gave me a copy of his research that he had given to various family members. His work inspired me to continue and fill in dates, places, etc. I used his basic information and was able to fill in a lot of blanks and extend lines to the latest generation. Without his research, I may never have gotten interested in genealogy which has become my favorite "hobby".

After Bartholomew's death, Mary married George Fishcher and had 3 children.

Christina died 2 months after her child was born. They are all buried in the Bethany Cemetery located about 5 miles from the old Ebenezer Church and Cemetery on banks of the Savannah River.

In 1810 Thomas Jr. returned to Effingham Co.,GA. He joined the Georgia Militia during the War with Great Britain of 1812-14 and served in Manning's 35th as a Private. In 1832 he moved his family to Baker Co.,GA, and at this time received land in Decatur Co.for his military service and moved there about 1838, settling in the Brinson area (extreme sw corner of GA near Florida/Alabama line.

More on Peter Mock Sr. of Frederick Co., MD

Received today (May 8) from prospective new member to editor from Paul R. Swan, P.O. Box 6036 #1631599, Englewood, CO 80155:

"My attention was drawn to your advertisement in the Nov-Dec *Genealogical Helper* for the *Mock Family Historian*. My mother's mother's mother was a **Margaret Mock**, dau. of **Christian** and wife of **David Burger Teeter**, so I am very interested in you research clearinghouse.

I've included for your information a prientout of all of the Mock notes that I've gathered so far. They are in the form of a tentative, unproven lineage"

Peter Mock and Elizabeth?

Peter was born about 1727, and was married to Elizabeth? He died 3 Apr 1812 in Frizzellburg, Frederick, (now Carroll), Maryland. The record of Peter's death is from the Baust Church Cemetery in Frizzellburg, Uniontown Township, Frederick (now Carroll) county, Maryland. His death 3 Apr 1812 at age 85 enables us to estimate his birth year as about 1727. The Baust Church was originally organized sometime before 1794, and its church building was jointly used by the Lutheran and Reformed. congregations. In the same cemetery is buried Margaret Mock who died 2 Jan 1815 aged 64. She might be either a spinster, or a wife with that married surname. If the former, she could be a daughter of Peter.

On 1 Mar 1783 a **Peter Mock** sold Lot 168 in Jerusalem Town, Washington Co.,MD, for 30 pounds to William Walter. **Elizabeth Mock** is recorded as having relinquished her dowry in that land, which provides our only evidence so far for the name of Peter's wife. That this transaction refers to **Peter Sr.** follows from the report that **Peter Jr.** had moved to Bedford Co..PA some fifteen years earlier.

There was a **Peter Mock** who served in the 5th Class of Capt. Jacob Sarer's Co. of the MD Militia in Washington Co.,MD, some forty miles to the west. A Daniel Whetstone, a name related to our Burger ancestors, was in the 2nd Class of the same

company. There was also a William Mock in 3rd Class of Capt. Hogmire's Company of that county.

We postulate that one child of **Peter** and **Elizabeth** (?) **Mock** was **Peter**, who was born about 1750 and died before 4 Apr 1817.

According to the *Bedford County History* (Anon., 1884) **Peter Mock** moved from Maryland about 1768 and settled on Bobb's Creek in Union Township, Bedford, Pennsylvania. Finding the land too wet, he moved south to the hills of the next township, St. Clair. He had eight sons and one daughter who married **Frederick Carn.**

Editor's Note: Paul Swan has obviously done a great deal of research on this family. I will send him this issue in appreciation for his contribution to the MFH, most of which I have not printed. FROM OUR MEMBERS.....

First let me say that I am pleased to be counted among the new members of the **Mock Family Historian**. Like many of you, I have toiled mostly alone for years without the knowledge that there were so many other kindred soles equally devoted to persuing the history of those bearing the **Mock** family name or one of its many derivations.

I have, perhaps, some new information, a few observations and comments to share with those who are researching the **Rowan Co.,NC Mock Lines**. My comments will, generally speaking, be in reference to articles submitted in previous issues of the newsletter.

1. Vol. I No. 1, pg 3/4 Peter/John/Alexander Mock - Ref. PA. Oaths of Allegience, Gen. Publ. Co., Egle In my research, regarding the Ship St. Catherine, I noted only Peter Mack and Johannes Mack. (23 Sept 1752) I do have mention of an Alexander Mack family associated with the Allen (15 Sept 1729). Could someone out there provide me with the reference material used to connect Alexander to the ship St. Catherine?

It has been noted, this **Peter Mock** is the same one who migrated to Rowan, it is not likely that he remained in PA for any length of time. Such a premise appears to be born out by the noticeable absence of references to **Peter** in any of the PA church records (at least that I have reviewed). There is enough hard information available to establish **Peter's** presence in Rowan at least as early as 1778 as opposed to the 1784 date most often quoted. Most notable among the references available is Richard Enochs' "Rowan Co. North Carolina Vacant Land Entries 1778-1789." Entry #1008 of 9 July 1778 reads: "HERMAN SPILMAN 640 A on the big Branch on the S side of the Yadkin R adjacent **Peter Mock** and Stephen Riddle....." and "#3031 of 11 Aug 1786, **Peter Mock**, etc., including his own improvements." It is clear from these legal entries that **Peter Mock**, had taken up residence in the Yadkin area sometime before July of 1778. A few other entrys listed in this book are #1268, 5 Aug 1778 and #1250, 4 Aug 1778 (**Phillip Mock**), #1512, 15 Sep 1778 (**Dewalt Mock**) and #3032, 11 Aug 1786 (**Andrew Mock**).

Additionally, in "NC Genealogical Society Journal, Vol. 1 (1975)" 1773 Debtors of Col. John McGee, Orange Co., N.C., deceased, on pg. 41 is one **Peter Mock**. Many of the names found in this list are recognizable later as Rowan Co. inhabitants. Only Guilford Co. separated Rowan & Orange Co. in 1773. Who else might this **Peter** be?

As I have noted above, I feel that there is a good case to make for Peter's arrival in NC by or before 1773. I have not had access to Ms. Gray's book. Did she cite the source for determining **Peter's** marriage to **Barbara Martin** and the naming of the brothers?

- 2. Vol. 1 No. 2, pg 15 To **Katherine Mock:** John, who is my ancestor, was indeed married by 1795. See Rowan Co. marriage records: Re: **John Mock** and **Catherine Graves** (**Graff**), 4 Oct 1790, Bondsman: **Peter Mock** (with notation "Groom is German"). Would appreciate ref. to substantiating evidence of **Peter's** marriage to **Barbara Martin**. I have copy of an Indenture (land sold to John's father-in-law, **Conrod Graves**) which is signed **Johannes P.** (**Peter?**) **Mock** and **Catron C.** (her mark) **Mock** and witnessed by **Peter Mock**.
- 3. Vol. I No. 3, pg 27 To Ms. Dale Barton: You're a long ways from Albuquerque. How long has it been, 1985?) Have quite a bit of info on George & John. Would be glad to share what I have.

See "List of Non-Jurors Rowan Co." and "North Carolina Tax Payer" (Ratliff). Both list **Dewault Mock** for the year 1759. Also Vol 2 of Taxpayers lists a **Paul (Devault?) Mock** for the year 1761. I think we must presume that he was at least over the age of 18 which would place his birth at no later than 1741. What is his relationship to **Peter?** Possibly an older brother?? Incidently I have not reviewed the original tax lists referred to by Mr. Ratliff so I considered this info a secondary source.

"I just discovered the Mauck BB, and I'm so excited! I was born " Frankie Joan Carol Mauck" in Washington, D.C. on Nov. 23, 1941. My dad was Earle Lewis Mauck, b. 24 May 1890 in Princeton, Indiana. He and his 1st wife, Isabelle Grigsby Mauck, were divorced. They had one child, Earl Grigsby Mauck. He married (2nd), my mother, Grace Bible in 1922. His mother, Ada Wilhite Mauck, died when he was sixteen. Ada Wilhite m. Arthur Mauck and his father was Jacob Mauck who married Mary Milne. Since my dad died when I was eleven, I have very sketchy information about our family tree, and I'd appreciate any information I could get! I've been told that the original Maucks were French Heugonauts, who came over to America because of being persecuted by Queen Catherine. The first Mauck supposedly was an indentured servant who came to Virginia in the 1600's. If any of this can be documented, please let me know. I found it interesting that there was an indenture dated 22 April 1784 between George Volk and George Mock, since I'm now married to a Volk!"

Ron Moore, MFH member, promptly answered Frankie with the following information:

Frankie, I have studied your information in greater detail, and it appears that M. Isabelle Grigsby must have been your father's 1st wife, and it appears that **Dovie Kendle's** mother was a **Spore**, and the **Spore** line traces back to the **John Mauck** family. **John** was a son of **Peter Mauck** who was in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia in the early 1730's. Most of the **John Mauck** line eventually moved to Harrison Co.,IN. **Earl Grigsby Mauck** must be your half brother, right? There is no indication from this book that your father is descended from **Peter Mauck**. It would be of interest for you to find out if your father and his first wife may have been distant cousins. It would be necessary for you to trace his line back generation by generation. As I noted before, if you have no one to give you the info, the death certificate is often a good place to start. I and several others on the board here, I am sure, would be happy to help you. **JP Mock** has a huge database on the **Virginia Maucks**. That was quite a coincidence that your father was located in (Wm. Wolph's book), "**The Descendants of Peter Mauck**", because he may or may not be connected, and it appears that he was in the book, not because he was a **Mauck**, but because he was married to **M. Isabelle Grigsby** who was a descendant of **Peter Mauck**.
