

Frescott Nezckiah, (P. H. or Jimmie), was born in Monon-gahela, Pa. on 13 April 1888, worked on the Panama Canal excavation as a steamshovel craneman from October 1909 to October 1913. In 1928 on 13th. of April he married Helen Junita Curtis. At this time I feel we should dedicate this newsletter to this wonderful cousin, P. H. the one being responsible for leaving so much Carmack genealogy behind for all of us to share. On April 30, 1954 P. H. died in Tos Angeles, Ca.

Helen Jaunita Curtis was born May 10, 1897 and was living in 1964. Helen and P. H. had no children but claimed "Butch", a black cat.

Prescott Hezekiah Carmack, son of Shelby Crall Carmack 1862-1387 and his wife Tillie May Shepler Carmack; grandson of Hezekiah Carmack 1826-1911 and his wife Louisa Crall Carmack, Louisa's mother was Hannah James Gaskill first cousin of Jefferson Davis; great-grandson of Abraham Carmack 1799-1963 and his wife Susannah Wickham; great-great-grandson of Peter 4.4. 3. of this newsletter.

A.4. Evan Carmack, born 25 February 1740, Frederick Co., Md., Son of William & Jane Carmack, In 1802-1807 he lived in Bedford Co., Pa. In 1928 Sarah Adams joined the Daughters of the American Revolution on Evan being a patriot this line was latter closed due to there being no proff of the birth of Evan's children, in 1984 Arlene Dixon of Carmack Coucins was able to find proff of birth on her Jacob Carmack and reopen her line. Arlene found batism records on Jacob Caremake son of Evan & Mary Caremake in the Evangelical & Reformed Church, 555 West James St., Lancaster, Pa. Baptism of Jacob Caremake was performed on March 24, 1769. These records were found among private records of the Rev. Jacob Lischy, 1743-1769. Congratulations to Arlene Dixon, Lodi, Ca. on her research!!!!!!!

Married-Mary Wolfe, born 1748, died 3 January 1805, Wheeling, West Va., daughter of Paul & Margaret Wolfe, sister to Sarah Wolfe Carmack who Married Evan's brother John. Evan above died before 1814 in Wheeling, West Va.

In Paul Wolfe's Will he mentions his son-in-law Evan Carmack, son-in-law John Carmack and his two daughters Mary Carmack and Sarah Carmack, he also mentions his grandaughter Sarah Carmack, daughter of Evan and Mary Carmack.




