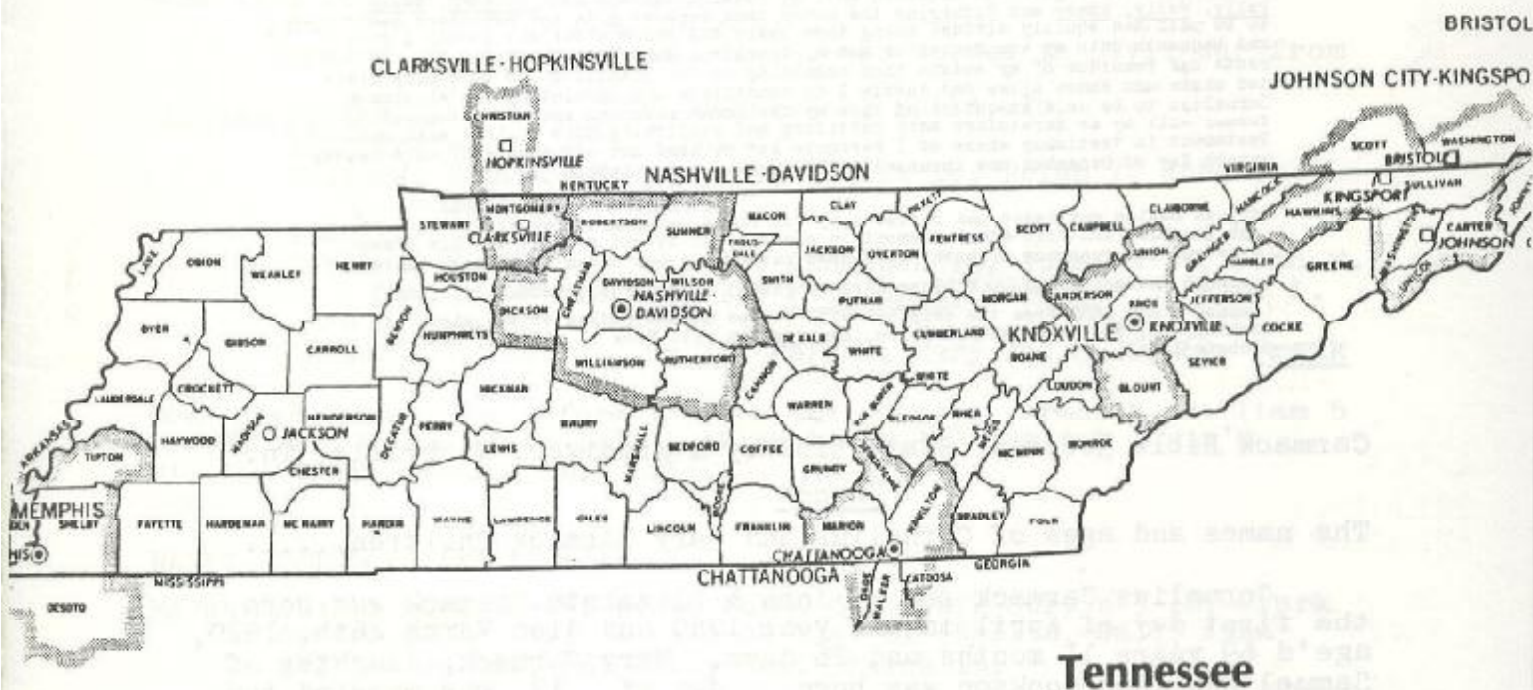

Will of Cornelius Carmack 1750-1820

In the name of God amen I Cornelius Carmack of the County of Hawkins & State of Tennessee being Sick in Body but of a sound and disposing mind memory and understanding considering the sirtainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worthy affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall pleas God to call me hence do therefore make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following Vis -

First and privestelly I commit my soul into the hands of almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried. I then demis & bequeath unto son Isaac the tract of land on which he now lives according as it was laid off to him and his heirs except fifty achors to be taken off across the lower end which fifty achors I demis & bequeath unto my son John together with the track on which was laid off for him and now lives on to him the said John his heirs and assigns I also give demis & bequeath unto my son William the tract of land on which he now lives together with twelve rods wide across to be taken of the lower end of the plantation on I also give & bequesta unto my son Cornelius the plantation on which I now live according to the pattent to him the said Cornelius his heirs and assigns I do also cause my above name sons for the named land above demise and bequeathed to them pay unto my executors herein after mensoned the sum of two dollars pr Achr which is to be paid within three years after my death to the excoutors with all debts. I also give & bequeath unto my grand children of my daughter Rachel the sum of two hundred dollars to be equally divided among them by my executors, I also give demis & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth the sum of five Dollars to her and her heirs, I also give and bequeath unto my other daughters Viz Susannah, Sally, Polly, Nelly, Nancy and Catherine the money then remaining in the executors hands to be paid and equilly divided among them share and share alike and lastly I give and bequeath unto my son Cornelius and my daughters Nancy and Catherine all the reste and reasidus of my estate then remaining on the plantation to be equilly divided share and share alike and lastly I do constitute and appoint my son William & Cornelius to be sole executors of this my testasent revoking and annulling all former will by me heretofore maid rattifying and confirming this my last will and Testament in testimony where of I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this twenty-ninth day of December one thousand eight hundred and eithteen.

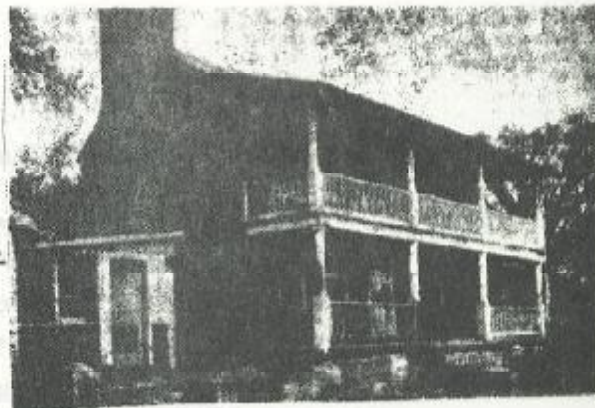

Marguerite K. Lanham, Attorney At Law, born October 6, 1905 in Sequatchie Valley, Marion Co., Tn. She is the daughter of Joseph Franklin and Nancy F. Grayson Kelley, and the granddaughter of Joseph B. & Mary Jane Carmack Kelley, (See Vol. 1, No. 4, June, 1985 of Carmack Cousins, (B.2.g.2)) Mrs. Lanham attended the University of Chattanooga and earned her law degree from the College of Law in 1935. She was the second woman from Hamilton Co., Tn. to be introduced to the Supreme Court of Tn.; and the first woman to be admitted to practice law before the Federal District Court in Chattanooga. While using the name Margurite K. Lanham in her law work, our cousin is the widow of Robert M. Lanham. She is still actively engaged in practice of law, with the firm of O'Rear & Lanham, located in Chatta. Let's all remember Margurite our cousin as she celebrates her 81st. birthday October 6, 1986. JOSEPH WARREN CARMACK, born May 26, 1838 Overton Co., Tn., died July 2, 1918 Dadeville, Mo., never married. Son of John and Elizabeth Chappin Carmack. Great-Gr-Grandson Cornelius Carmack 1736-1824. On April 1, 1853 John Carmack and his family embarked for the west, wife and seven children, landing in Dadeville, Mo. June 14, 1853. Joseph Warren was then 16 years old. Education experience before leaving Tn. was nine months, could spell, read and write. In Mo. schooling of three months for \$30.00 this was called High-school.

Military service- Sixth Cavalry Mo. Volunteers, Melville (Dadeville) Mo. Served as Second Lieutenant, this co. was relieved and mustered out on October 31, 1864. After being discharged on Nov. 1, 1864 for service in 76th. Regiment he was again commissioned as First Lieutenant in the Veterans US Service and placed in charge of recruiting for the 14th. Veterans Calvary "Missouri Vols", on October 20, 1865 the 14th. Calvary Missouri Volunteers was disbanded and all set sail for home. Later after returning home Joseph Warren was once again Commissioned as First-Lieutenant for state of Mo. Militia.

JESSE WASHINGTON "WASH" CARMACK, born September 1, 1841 Overton Co., Tn., died June 9, 1924 Overton Co., Tn., buried- Mt Gilead Cemetery, Hilham, Tn. Great-grandson of Cornelius Carmack 1736-1824, Great-Grandfather of Editor-Agnes Jones. Married-Lucy Almira Nolen on Jan. 4, 1866 in Jackson Co., Tn.

Wash Carmack was one of the first listed among the privates of Co. 7. Fifth Tn. Regiment, Confederate Army, organized in Livingston, Tn., on May 1861 with Calvin "B" Myers. Capt these 86 men were the first soldiers from Overton Co., Tn. to be organized in this war. On May 11, 1861 marching on foot to Celina where they were loaded on flat boats & floated down the Cumberland river to Nashville, Tn., from there they marched to Camp Trousdale where they were united with eight Tn. Confederate Regiment. After leaving for service his family did not hear from him for four years, everyone thought he was dead.

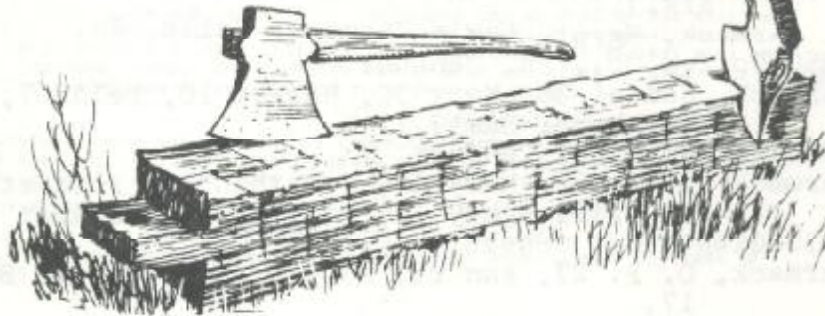
