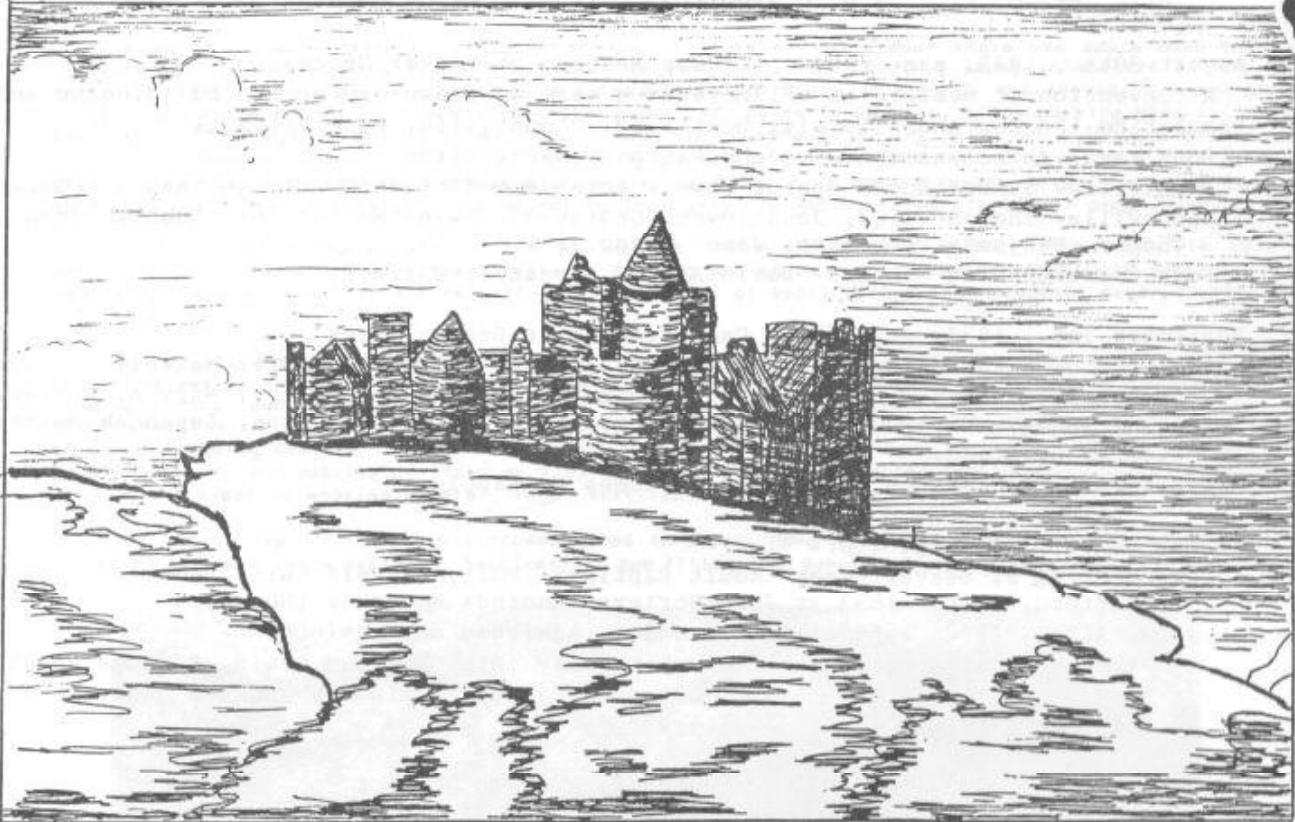

#### CARMACKS VISIT CHINA

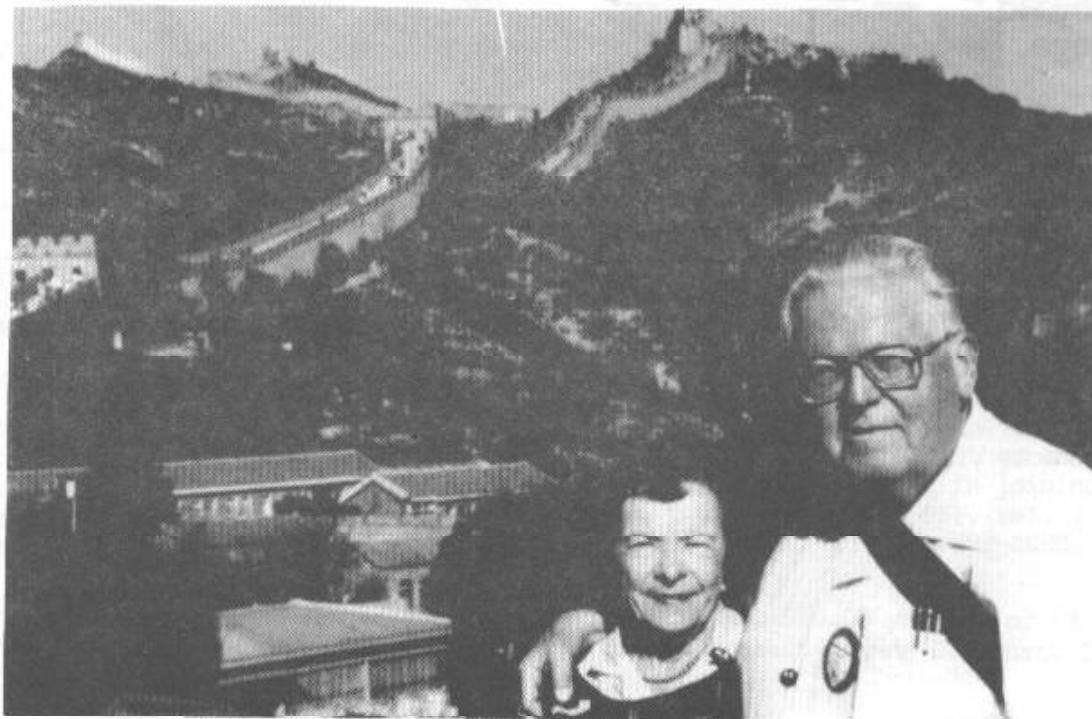
In October 1985, Marvin and Joan Carmack travelled in The Peoples' Republic of China as members of a group of 17 scientists and 11 spouses representing the American Institute of Chemists, led by the President of the A.I.C. We were hosted by the China Association for Science and Technology (CAST), an official government agency responsible for hosting groups of scientists and arranging meetings, lectures, and seminars. We visited five major cities in two weeks: Beijing, Hangzhou, Yangzhou, Guilin, and Gangzhou (Canton). During that time we were meeting with both small and large groups—sometimes lecturing to large groups, sometimes sitting about a conference table with a small group discussing mutual interests. As a Professor Emeritus of Organic Chemistry at Indiana University, Marvin was interested in the chemistry of natural products, medicinal chemistry, and the chemistry of mammalian pheromones. He met for most of one day in Beijing with a group working on the chemistry of pheromones in rodents and in wild animals of China. He and Mrs. Carmack had the great pleasure of having a fine dinner and an evening of wonderful conversation in the apartment of Dr. and Mrs. Lin Yi. Dr. Lin had received his Ph.D. in chemistry at the University of Pennsylvania in 1951 at the time when Marvin was Professor there, so there was much to catch up on. Dr. Lin had become, in the intervening 34 years, a distinguished senior research chemist at the Institute of Chemistry in Beijing, and had made a valuable contribution to the economy of China by the development of a process for manufacturing silicone polymers.

In spite of much official visiting of the chemists of the group, there was ample opportunity for sightseeing. For our pleasure, we were assigned chemistry students and young scientists to act as our special guides, and several of these have subsequently corresponded with us and several are now studying or working in the U.S.A. Our very attractive young lady guide in Beijing is now working hard on her Ph.D. degree in metallurgy at Columbia University, and her husband is trying to arrange to come also from his work at the Cement Research Institute. Our young physicist-guide in Guilin has been on a tour of General Electric centers in the U. S. because his company in China that manufactures heavy industrial electrical equipment has signed a contract with GE for collaboration in making large electrical capacitors.

We found the young people on the streets in China universally friendly and eager to talk with Americans (we met teenagers on the streets in Beijing who study English and can talk with visitors in that language). Our universities are receiving large numbers of applications from students eager to come to the U.S. to study.

Guilin has some of the most spectacular scenery and is the inspiration for many of the familiar scenes we see in the art work from China in this country. Guangzhou (Canton) is only a few hours by train from Hong Kong, and is famous for its great Trade Fair, which we were fortunate to be able to visit for a few hours. Two large city blocks of 5-story buildings were filled with an astounding variety of articles of commerce being offered to importers attending the show from all over the world. We were amazed at the great diversity and quality of items on display, including many advanced instruments, tools, chemicals, as well as the expected wearing apparel, rugs, textiles, and foodstuffs.

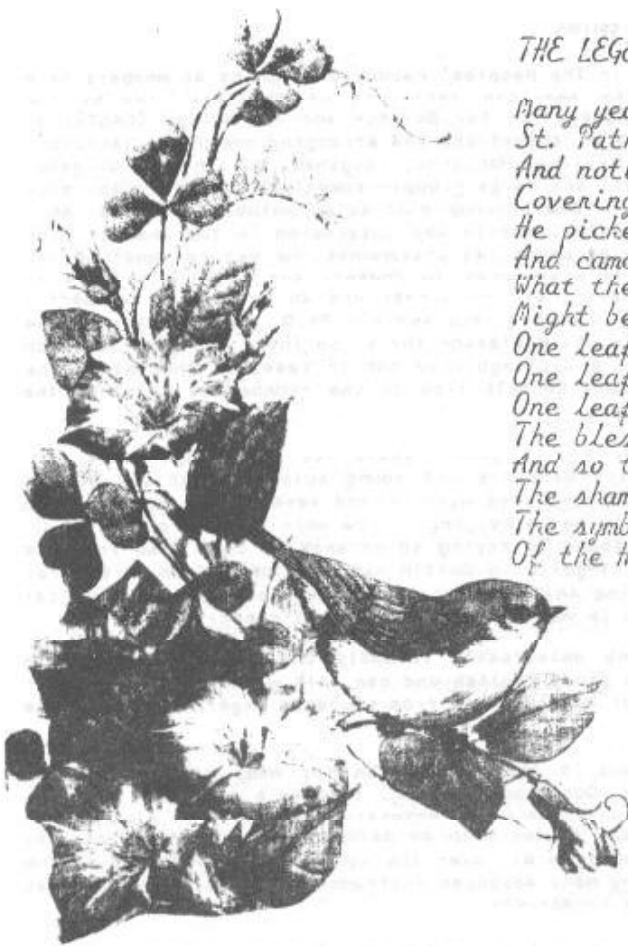
