

NORTH CAROLINA CRAVEN COUNTY

To the Worshipfull Court of Craven County Petition of Lydia Carmack, widow of James Carmack show that your petitioner's husband inducted as a soldier in the Continental Army in the year 1776 and marched Northward with the troops of the State, where he remained as a soldier for some time and as your petitioner has understood did his duty as such until he dyed, leaving her much distressed with four small children which your petitioner with great labor and in much poverty have supported ever since. That she is now and has been for some time reduced with her children to great distress in some measure owing to the cancer on the ankle that has for more than three years rendered her unable to go about and consequently to earn a livelyhood and understanding there is a law provided for the relief of those distressed familys whose husbands have been killed or dyed in the service of their country, your petitioner prays the assistance and recommendation of this worshipful court to the next General Assembly.

That such suitable allowance may be made her as you in your justice shall think fit

and your petitioner will ever

NORTH CAROLINA, CRAVEN COUNTY, COURT OF PLEAS & QUARTERS SESSION, SEPTEMBER TERM, 1818

The petition of Jerusha Carmack shows that Solomon Carmack the husband of your petitioner died some time about the 14th. of Sept., 1818, interstate possessed of a small personal estate and that administration thereon was granted at the Sept. Term to Jesse Carmack.

Petitioner prays for freeholders to be appointed to lay off year's allowance for support of hereself and family, and to make return thereon & etc.

C.- by John Carmack, age 75, swears he enlisted for 12 months, in Hillsboro, Orange Co., N. C. on or about Nov. 1, 1781 in Capt. Hall's Company 10th. Reg. under Col. Abraham Sheppard on continental establishment--marched to Oxford, Gransville Co., N. C., joining other troops--marched to the high hills of Santee, S. C. where they encamped the most of the time of his service--often out to disperse tories--frequent skirmishes before and after his enlistment---carries many of the wonds---continued to serve in war until Nov. 1, 1782--discharged in S. C.

Lists schedule of goods—he is a farmer but unable to labor—has been married twice—seven children by first wife—Levi, Betsy, Polly, 2 born dead and John. Levi, the oldest left home some years ago for the west—has never heard from him—Polly is dead—Betsy, from last account is in Davidson Co., N. C.—John is very unhealthy—his wife, now about 45 is sickly—by her he had six children—Lucretia married, two children, Nancy, Maria, Win about 11 years old, Eaphance(?) died and Polly about 4 years old.

Delcration-Nov. 22, 1845, Guilford Co., N. C.--by Mary Carmack, age 71-swears she is the widow of John Carmack, who died June 1, 1844--that she married him in 1791 or 92--she has no family record. *Marriage Records- John Carmack to Mary Daugherty 31st. Jan. 1789.

Children by 1st. Marriage- wife unknown: Levi, Polly, Betsy, John & two were still born. John Carmack & Mary Children:

Lucretia, Nancy, Maria, Eaphrim, William Born ca. 1821, Polly born ca. 1828.

C. Carmack who is in search of your roots along with many others. Let's thank Charles Carmack, Garden City, Mi. for finding Janice.

In a letter Janice received from the Dept. of Archives & History, Raleigh, N. C., Military Information, letter dated May 2, 1847 to the clerk of the Co. Court, Randolph Co, from Dickerson Carmack. Dickerson states that his grandfather was John Carmack who lived and died in Guilford Co, this John being the son of John Carmack of Cravens Co. Dickeson Carmack also mentions that his grandfather had two sons william and John.

As we all know there is still a lot of work to be done on our N. C. Carmacks but one question what is the connection between James Carmack & wife Lydia, James Carmack that was a soldier in the Continental Army in the year 1776. Mary Carmack, Estate Sale Dec. 21, 1786, and John Carmack who served in the Contiental Establishment enlisting around 1781. We must ask another question is there any connection between these Carmacks and the Carmack's in Frederick Co., Md., also Dennis & Bridgett Carmack and son James as we all have no information what happened to James, did he die or where did he go?
