

Complaints would show your Honor that R. H. Carmack departed this life in Davidson County, Tennessee, at the residence of the complaints on the ____day of ___1911, leaving at last will and testament, which is in words and figures following:

"The Last Will and Testament of Richard N. Carmack."

I, Richard N. Carmack; being of sound mind and despairing memory, do make this as my last will and testament, I will and order that all land and real estate, that I die possessed of be sold to the best advantage, and the proceeds of such sale be divided and given unto my following named nieces and nephews in the following amount and proportions: To my niece May I. Rains, I will and bequeath fifteen hundred dollars, of the proceeds of real estate sales; to my nieces Nannie Carter and Hettie T. Carmack five hundred dollars each of the sales of land money; to my niece Annie Oden, two hundred dollars of the proceeds of land sales. The balance of money, if there be any, from proceeds of land sale, I give and bequeath to my Herring nephews and nieces. All of my personal property, both cash, live stock, household

effects, etc., after my debts and burial expenses are paid, I will and bequeath unto my niece May I. Carmack.

Within my hand and seal.

R. N. Carmack

Witness- S. F. Oden.

M. S. Oden"

Said will was duly probated in the County Court of Davidson County, and the complainants John N. Rains and May I. Rains, qualified as administrators, with the will annexed.

The testator left surviving him as next of kin, nephews and nieces, children of deceased brothers and sisters, as follows: W. H. Carmack, Nannie Carter (nee Carmack), J. C. Carmack, J. I. Carmack, and Nettie Davis (nee Carmack), children of Samuel Carmack, deceased.

Theresa Roach, a widow, Hinton Carmack, Lula Bateman, and Mrs. Annie Oden, children of William Carmack, deceased.

Sam Herring, J. Thomas Herring, Herbert Herring, Daniel Herring, R. Emerson Herring, Eunice Cothran (nee Herring), and W. W. Herring, children of Margaret Ann Herring, deceased, a sister of the testator. These are the Herring Nephews and Nieces referred to in the will.

May I. Rains (nee May I. Carmack), daughter of H. H. Carmack brother of the testator.

Complaints would show your Honor that in pursuance to the provisions of the will, they have taken charge of the personal property, paid the debts and burial expenses and the reminder has been turned over to complainant May I. Rains.

It will be observed from the provisions of the will that the testator directors that his real estate be sold, and the proceeds divided among his nieces and nephews as follows:

To May I. Rains \$1,500.00

To Nannie Carter and Nettie T. Carmack, \$500.00 each,

To Annie Oden. \$200.00

and the balance of the proceeds to be paid over to the Herring nephews and nieces who are named in the caption of the bill.

The real estate mentioned in the will consists of a farm lying in the 6th., Civil District of Davidson County, Tennessee, (formerly the 16th., Civil District of Williamson County)

Margaret and Marshall both buried in Robinson Cemetery, Tipton County, Tennessee. Cemetery located on road between Mason and Covington, Tennessee.


