"Boss's Day was observed with a surprise party at the Bethany Book Store. The blocks were assembled and the final quilting done by the present employees. It was presented to Jean Ladd, the present manager, who joined the store in 1955. The Bethany Book Store has been at the same location since 1949. The present staff represents over 150 years of experience in service to the community and state."
