2. MARTHA³ BRADY (PHOEBE² ELSTON, WILLIAM¹)⁵ was born April 14, 1821 in Washington Twp., Darke Co., Ohio, and died Unknown. She married (1) **NATHAN B. HILLER** August 24, 1837, son of JOHN S. HILLER. He was born Abt. 1821 in Ohio, and died Aft. 1845 in Greenville, Darke Co., Ohio. She married (2) **ALEXANDER [HAYS] HAYES** 1847⁶. He was born Abt. 1804, and died Unknown.

Notes for MARTHA BRADY:

Remarried to Alexander Hays.

SPECIAL NOTE:

The Darke Co. Common Pleas Court Records, 1817-1860, compiled by Anita Short and Ruth Bowers, 1972, includes these entries:

"11-24-1834 - James Brady appointed guardian of Lavina Mark aged 10 yrs. and Amanda Mark aged 6 yrs. children of John and Elizabeth MARK, dec'd. (450)" (Minute Book 3, p. 12 of index; seen in Garst Museum on 9 June 1998).

"9-1-1835 - James Brady appointed guardian of George MARK, a minor (63)" (Minute Book 4, p. 14 of index).

"12-19-1838 - Phebe Brady and John C. Brady appointed adms. of the estate of James Brady, dec'd. (47)" (Minute Book 5, index p. 25).

James Brady was appointed Justice of the Peace of Washington Twp. in 1836 (Court Records, Part III, Misc. Records, index p. 129).

Notes for NATHAN B. HILLER:

A cemetery record book shows burial of Isaac C. Hiller in Greenville Cemetery. He had been in Ohio Infantry, Co K. No date given. This is the same military unit into which Isaac Stilwell enlisted.

The Marriage Records, 1807-1865, Miami Co., Ohio (seen in Troy Historical Society libr., 9 June 1998):

Hiller, John - Sarah E. Funk 10-4-1836. [THIS IS ONLY NOTED HERE IN CASE OF NEED LATER.....no connection made at this point].

12. PHEBE ANN⁴ HILLER (MARTHA³ BRADY, PHOEBE² ELSTON, WILLIAM¹) was born November 29, 1840 in Darke Co., OH, and died June 12, 1886 in Schell City, Vernon/Bates Co., MO⁹. She married **WILLIAM HENRY STILLWELL** December 14, 1870 in Greenville, Darke Co., OH [by Henry Cole, Preacher of the Christian Church]¹⁰, son of DANIEL STILLWELL and BEULAH _____. He was born February 09, 1846 in Troy, Miami Co., OH¹¹, and died January 16, 1925 in Cushing, Payne Co., OK¹².
