The other tract granted to David Smith by Thomas Pinckney Governor for the time being, on the second day of June one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight containing Six hundred & forty Acres and bounded South Easterly on the above described land South Westerly on Jonathan Clarks land & John Robinsons On all other sides vacant land, having Such Shape forms & Marks as is exhibited in the Plat to the Original Grant annexed.
