Palmetto Sharpshooters S.C.V.C.S.P.A." with notes on colleagues' furloughs, discharges, casualties, etc., and the "Roster of The Palmetto Sharpshooters Surrendered at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9th 1865"
