

The Division of Joseph Dear humbly shews
That your Father was a resident of this place
the 1st January 1780 and after the Fall of Fort Mifflin
he became a Refugee with Col. Benjamin Chew
under whose care he fought at the battle of Red Bank
Mountain and was there wounded by having his
right breast shot Oct. 1780. And from thence he
was conveyed with the wounded to the Quaker
Brethren and lay there under the Doctor's care
two Months, under which Circumstances
your Father suffered, Not being able to draw
any Relief from the Public until the year 1780
