--- 1st Generation ---

1. Dougald¹ MACFARLANE (36).

His birthplace is said to have been Druim Lighart. Druim Lighart is a site not marked on the Ordnance Survey map, but it is close to the line of the modern West Highland Way as it swings past Inveroran and on towards Victoria Bridge and the old military road to Glen Coe.

"His parents and all his people were Presbyterians. Dougald was a precocious lad and at the head of his class in school. There is a family tradition that the stories told him by his pastor, when teaching him his catechism, had something to do with his change in religion...."

When Dougald had finished his school days in "Gleann Urchaidh" he left home and shaped his course toward the north and west. He was soon engaged as schoolteacher in one of the districts of Knoydart. While in this situation the blue eyes of a neighboring Cloe took possession of his imagination and inspired his day-dreams. Margaret MacDonell, who had made him her captive, was possessed in her proper person of the graces and goodly gifts that generally play havoc with the mental fortifications of bards and pedagogues. Besides, she belonged to one of the best families in the district; she was a daughter of "Fear Chrolem", and granddaughter of the Laird of the Scots - septes of the Glengarry family. She was a sister to the famous Colonel John MacDonell, "Spanish John" as he was called in Canada, who died in Cornwall, Ontario, in 1820.

Dougald MacFarlane was married in Knoydart, Scotland, to Margaret MacDonell, and was received into the Church at the same time."

Dougald and Margaret's children were born and raised in Glenfinnan. But this was a time of great disruption in the Highlands. "In one year alone fifty-four emigrant ships sailed from the western sealochs. Though some of the emigrants were the families of soldiers who had fought in the Americas, and who had chosen to settle there on grants of land, most were led and organized by small tackmen who wished to escape the rack-renting of their chiefs. - - - A growing population, a decaying economy, recurrent famines and bitter poverty made exile inevitable for increasing numbers. - - -"

From the beginning the emigrants were the victims of speculators and ship masters, of typhus, cholera and dysentery. - - -

One of the most successful contractors was George Dunoon of Fort William who, with his partners, made a comfortable fortune shipping Glengarry and Strathglass people across the Atlantic to Pictou in Nova Scotia. - - -

Conditions aboard the emigrant ships were seldom better than abominable - - -.

In the summer of 1801, George Dunoon advertised the sailing of the *Sarah* and the *Dove* from Fort William to Pictou. Had the laws then governing slave-ships applied to these emigrant vessels they would not have been allowed to carry more than 489 passengers. Dunoon filled the tiny holds with 700, emigrants from Lord Reay's country, from the clan-lands of Seaforth, Fraser and Cameron. If they believed his promise that in Nova Scotia they would find a tree that supplied fuel, soap and sugar (he probably meant the maple) they may have found the nightmare voyage endurable, but it is unlikely. Forty-nine people died on the *Sarah* alone, and the suffering of all was so terrible that it was remembered in Nova Scotia for more than a century."

"He [Dougald] and his family came to America in the year 1801, in the "Dove of Aberdeen". The parents, with the younger members of the family, remained at the Gulf, while the grownup boys were preparing a home for them at the South River. They had a family of four sons and five daughters.

Among the first settlers at South River was Dougald MacFarlane." He was also known in Gaelic as Dhughall MACPHADRUIG 'ic Phadraig 'ic Iain 'ic Illechrìosd 'ic Iain (36). He was born circa 1720 at Glenorchy, Scotland. He married Margaret MACDONELL (37) circa 1775 at Knoydart, Invernessshire, Scotland. He died after 1813 at Antigonish, Nova Scotia, Canada.

--- 2nd Generation ---

2. Patrick/Peter² MACFARLANE (38) married an unknown person. Patrick/Peter (38) was born circa 1700 at Scotland.

32. Iain/John⁶ MACFARLANE (42) married an unknown person. Iain/John (42) was born circa 1590 at Scotland.

--- 7th Generation ---

64. Andrew⁷ MACFARLANE (5783) was born circa 1560 at Scotland. He died before Oct 1623 at Scotland.

--- 8th Generation ---

128. Andrew "Dubh"⁸ MACFARLANE 2nd of Gartartan or Gartvertane (5784) was born circa 1524 at Scotland. He died before 1611 at Scotland.

--- 9th Generation ---

256. Walter⁹ MACFARLANE 1st of Gartartan or Gartvertane (5785) was born circa 1506 at Scotland. He married Janet GALBRAITH of that Ilk & Culcreauch (5786), daughter of James GALBRAITH of that Ilk, 7th of Culcreauch (5787), circa 1520 at Scotland. He died on 10 Sep 1547 at Pinkie, Scotland.

--- 10th Generation ---

512. Sir Iain/John¹⁰ MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 11th Baron, 8th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5788) was born circa 1480 at Scotland. He married the Honourable (--?--) HERRIES (5789), daughter of Herbert HERRIES 1st Lord Herries (5790), circa 1500 at Scotland. He died on 9 Sep 1513 at the Battle of Flodden, Northumberland, England.

--- 11th Generation ---

1024. Andrew¹¹ MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 10th Baron, 7th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5791) was born circa 1460 at Scotland. He married Lady Barbara STUART (5792), daughter of John STUART 10th Earl of Lennox (5793), circa 1480 at Scotland.

1025. Lady Barbara¹¹ STUART (5792) was born circa 1460 at Scotland. She married Andrew MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 10th Baron, 7th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5791), son of Walter MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 9th Baron, 6th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5794) and Mlle. (--?--) LIVINGSTON (5795), circa 1480 at Scotland.

--- 12th Generation ---

2048. Walter¹² MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 9th Baron, 6th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5794) was born circa 1440 at Scotland. He married Mlle. (--?--) LIVINGSTON (5795), daughter of James LIVINGSTON 2nd Lord Livingston (5796), circa 1460 at Scotland. He died on 11 Jun 1488 at possibly at the battle of Sauchieburn near Stirling, Scotland.

2049. Mlle. (--?--)¹² LIVINGSTON (5795) was born circa 1440 at Scotland. She married Walter MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 9th Baron, 6th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5794), son of Duncan MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 8th Baron, 5th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5797), circa 1460 at Scotland.

2050. John¹² STUART 10th Earl of Lennox (5793) was born circa 1430 at Scotland.

--- 13th Generation ---

4096. Duncan¹³ MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 8th Baron, 5th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5797) was born circa 1420 at Scotland. He died in 1468 at possibly the Battle of Stalc, in Appin on the west coast of Scotland, Scotland.

4098. James¹³ LIVINGSTON 2nd Lord Livingston (5796) was born circa 1410 at Scotland.

--- 14th Generation ---

8192. Iain/John¹⁴ MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 7th Baron, 4th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5798) was born circa 1396 at Scotland. He married Mlle. Jean MURE of Rowallan (5799), daughter of Sir Adam MURE of Rowallan, 2nd Baron (5800), circa 1420 at Scotland. He died before 18 Jan 1441 at Scotland.

8193. Mlle. Jean¹⁴ MURE of Rowallan (5799) was born circa 1396 at Scotland. She married Iain/John MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 7th Baron, 4th Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5798), son of Duncan MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 6th Baron, 3rd Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5801) and Mlle. Christian CAMPBELL of Lochawe (5802), circa 1420 at Scotland.

--- 15th Generation ---

16384. Duncan¹⁵ MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 6th Baron, 3rd Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5801) was born circa 1365 at Scotland. He married Mlle. Christian CAMPBELL of Lochawe (5802), daughter of Sir Colin CAMPBELL of Lochawe, 3rd Baron (5803), circa 1396 at Scotland. He died before 1426 at Scotland.

16385. Mlle. Christian¹⁵ CAMPBELL of Lochawe (5802) was born circa 1365 at Scotland. She married Duncan MACFARLANE of that Ilk & Arrochar, 6th Baron, 3rd Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5801), son of Malcolm MACFARLANE of Arrochar, 5th Baron, 2nd Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5804), circa 1396 at Scotland.

16386. Sir Adam¹⁵ MURE of Rowallan, 2nd Baron (5800) was born circa 1370 at Scotland.

--- 16th Generation ---

32768. Malcolm¹⁶ MACFARLANE of Arrochar, 5th Baron, 2nd Chief of the Clan MacFarlane (5804) was born circa 1320 at Scotland. He died before 10 Jun

1395 at Scotland.

32770. Sir Colin¹⁶ CAMPBELL of Lochawe, 3rd Baron (5803) was born circa 1340 at Scotland.

--- 17th Generation ---

65536. Parlan¹⁷ DE ARROCHAR 4th Baron, First Chief of Clan MacFarlane (5805) was also known in Gaelic as Pharlan MACMAOLDOMHNAICH (5805). He was born circa 1290 at Scotland. He died before 4 May 1354 at Scotland.

--- 18th Generation ---

131072. Malduin¹⁸ DE ARROCHAR 3rd Baron (5806) was also known in Gaelic as Maoldomhnaich MACDONNACHAD (5806). He was born circa 1260 at Scotland.

--- 19th Generation ---

262144. Duncan¹⁹ DE ARROCHAR 2nd Baron (5807) was also known in Gaelic as Donnchad MACGILLECRIOSD (5807). He was born circa 1227 at Scotland. He married Mlle. Matilda DE LENNOX (5808) circa 1260 at Scotland.

262145. Mlle. Matilda¹⁹ DE LENNOX (5808) was born circa 1227 at Scotland. She married Duncan DE ARROCHAR 2nd Baron (5807), son of GilleCriosd/Gilchrist DE LENNOX 1st Baron of Arrochar (5809), circa 1260 at Scotland.

--- 20th Generation ---

524288. GilleCriosd/Gilchrist²⁰ DE LENNOX 1st Baron of Arrochar (5809) was also known in Gaelic as GilleCriosd MACAILIN (5809). He was born in 1192 at Scotland. He died after 1250 at Scotland.

--- 21st Generation ---

1048576. Ailin/Alwyn²¹ 2ND EARL OF LENNOX (5810) was born circa 1170 at Scotland. He married Lady Eva DE MENTEITH (5811), daughter of Gilchrist 1ST EARL OF MENTEITH (5812), circa 1192 at Scotland. He died before 1217 at Scotland.

1048577. Lady Eva²¹ DE MENTEITH (5811) was born before 1165 at Scotland. She married Ailin/Alwyn 2ND EARL OF LENNOX (5810), son of Ailin/Alwyn 1ST EARL OF LENNOX (5815), circa 1192 at Scotland.

--- 22nd Generation ---

2097152. Ailin/Alwyn²² 1ST EARL OF LENNOX (5815) died b1177/8 at Scotland. He was born circa 1125 at Scotland.

2097154. Gilchrist²² 1ST EARL OF MENTEITH (5812) was born circa 1150 at Scotland.

--- 23rd Generation ---

4194304. Murdac²³ MORMAER OF LENNOX (5813) was born circa 1100 at Scotland. He married (--?--) MACARKYL (5814), daughter of Alwyn MACARKYL (5816), circa 1125 at Scotland.

4194305. (--?--)²³ MACARKYL (5814) was born circa 1100 at Scotland. She married Murdac MORMAER OF LENNOX (5813), son of Maldouen MORMAER OF LENNOX (5817), circa 1125 at Scotland.

--- 24th Generation ---

8388608. Maldouen²⁴ MORMAER OF LENNOX (5817). May have witnessed a charter of King David I to Glasgow in c 1136. He was born circa 1075 at Scotland.

8388610. Alwyn²⁴ MACARKYL (5816). Prominent in the Court of King David I. He was born circa 1090 at Scotland.

--- 25th Generation ---

16777216. Murdac²⁵ MORMAER OF LENNOX (5818) was born circa 1050 at Scotland.
