To all people to whom these presents may come know ye that I Ebenezer Barnard of the County and City of Hartford Conn. for the consideration of One Thousand dollars received of Ralph Strong and Ralph Van Brunt of Bloomfield County of Ontario, State of New York have granted sold released and do by these presents confirm unto the said ~~Ralph~~ Ralph Van Brunt the following parcel of lands being and laying in the county of Ontario and State of N.Y. and in No. 11 in the 5th range of townships in the Genesee purchase and is lot No. 32 bounding North on No. 26 East on boundary lines of the 11,000 acre tract South on No. 38 West on No. 31 to contain 113 acres and no more to have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with the appenances thereof unto him the said Ralph Van Brunt and his heirs and assigns that at and untill the unsealing of these presents I am seased of these premises as a good and undefeasible estate in free simple and have good right to bargain and sell the same in manner and form as above written and that the same is free of all incumbrances whatsoever and furtle more I the said Barnard do by these presents bind myself and my heirs forever to warrent and defend the above granted and bargained premises to him the said Ralph Van Brunt his heirs and assigns against all claims and demands what so ever in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this 20th day of May A.D. 1813. Eben Barnard

STRONG, the late Harrison, Victor, was born at Wangan Mills, south of Fisher's, N.Y. Nearly $3/4$ of a mile. He was educated in the public schools and was a farmer. He married three times, 1st. on Jan.23,1840 to Sarah Cansman, she died Jan.22,1841; Second on Jan.20,1842 he married Martha Buckman, and they had six children; *Sherman Shaw Strong*
