This page is intended to be ramblings from me about Fonner connections I have not been able to prove but think are likely.

1. I think the Fonner's of Crawford Co., PA are related to the Greene Co., PA Fonner's as they both came from the same part of NJ (Hunterdon Co.)
2. I think it's possible that the Fonger's of NJ and the Fonner's of NJ are related.
3. Fonner/Fowner's (Maryland Fonner/Fowners on my website) from Baltimore to Nebraska are NOT related to most of the other Fonner families – mine for sure.
4. I know there are Irish Fonner's who came to USA in mid-1850's. There are other "Fonner's" who came to USA and will be proven as unrelated at least to me.
5. Though "my" Fonner's sometimes spelled their names Foner, Fenner, Fawner, Fanner and who knows what else, I ma not sure that other Fawner, Fohner families are related to my Fonnors.
6. Best guess is that "my" Fonnors came to US thru NY City or nearby and spent at least some time in Long Island area, then moved to New Jersey, before moving into various parts PA.
