On this ~~17th~~ day of March  
A D one thousand eight hundred and  
fifty personally appeared before me a  
justice of the peace within and for the  
County and State aforesaid Asa Davis  
aged seventy three years a resident  
of Mills County in the State of Iowa,  
who being duly sworn according to law  
declares that he is the identical Asa  
Davis who was a Volunteer in the  
Company commanded by Captain Gould  
Gyles in the Regiment of Volunteers  
Commanded by Col. Blakesley &  
still under the command of General  
Hall, in the war with Great Britain  
declared by the United States on the 18th  
day of June 1812 that he ~~volunteered~~ volun-  
teered at the Town of Livonia in  
Livingston County in the State of New-  
York in the month of November or  
December in the year A D 1813 he cannot  
state the precise date and that he continued  
in ~~the~~ <sup>actual</sup> service about three weeks in said  
War, that he has never had any written  
discharge that he was discharged at Buffa-  
lo in the State of New York in the month

of November or December A.D. 1813

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he is entitled under the <sup>act of Congress</sup> approved March 3<sup>d</sup> 1835 he also declares that he has not received a warrant for bounty land under this or any other act of Congress nor made any other application therefor. Except one which did not reach the proper Department as he is informed & believes

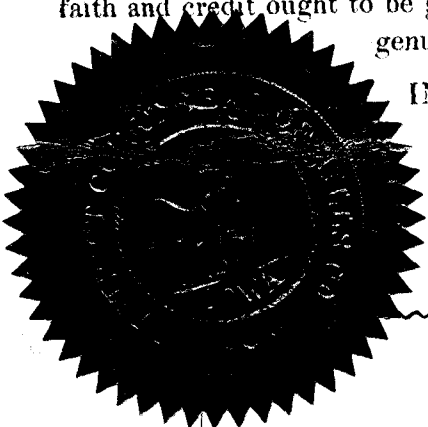

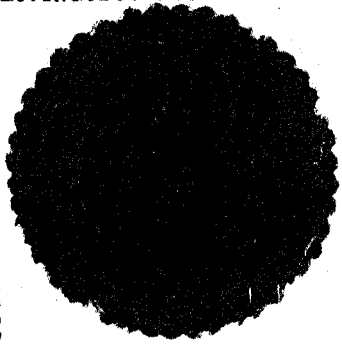
