

BOUNTY LAND CLAIM.

Form of Declaration for surviving Officer or Soldier.

STATE OF *New York*
COUNTY OF *Livingston* ss.

On this *17th* day of *March* A. D. one thousand eight hundred and *55* personally appeared before me, *S. N. Chamberlin* a Justice of the Peace duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the county and State aforesaid, *Rowland Powell* aged *64* years, a resident of *Levonida* in the State of *New York* who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical *Rowland Powell* who was a *Private* in the Company commanded by Captain *Silus* in the Regiment of *Militia* commanded by *Blakesley* in the war with *Great Britain* Declared by the United States on the *18th* Day of *June 1812* that he *voluntarily* entered in to service at *Levonida Livingston Co. New York* on or about the *15th* day of *December* A. D. *1812* for the term of *Not Stated* and continued in actual service in said war for the term of *about two weeks* and was honorably discharged at *Petavias Ferry* on the *15th* day of *January* A. D. *1814* on account of *Not Being wanted* as will appear by

the muster rolls of the company. He states that he never had a written discharge and further states that he was in the engagement at *Black Rock* at the time that *Buffalo* was burnt and further states that he cannot state positive the place of being discharged his Captain *Silus* was killed in actual

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the "act granting bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," passed ~~September 22nd, 1850~~ *March 3rd, 1850*; never having received or knowing that he is entitled under any former act of Congress.

Know all men by these presents, That I the said *Rowland Powell* of the county of *Livingston* and state of *New York* do hereby revoke and countermand all former powers of attorney given for the purpose of prosecuting any claims against the United States Government, and have constituted and appointed, and by these presents do constitute and appoint *S. B. Powell* of *Levonida New York*

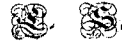
my true and lawful attorney, *irrevocably* for me and in my name to receive from the United States the bounty land certificate, or warrant, or pension certificate, and all such sum or sums of money due me on account of arrears of pay, three months' extra pay, forage, mileage, for horses and other property lost or destroyed in the military service, expenses incurred, or money expended for organizing volunteer companies before being mustered into the service of the United States, or any money or moneys which may be due me by the United States on any account whatsoever, and generally to do all lawful acts and things whatsoever touching the premises, and an attorney or attorneys under him for the purpose aforesaid, to make and at his pleasure to revoke, hereby confirming all and whatsoever my said attorney shall in my name legally do or cause to be done, in and about the premises.
