

Rathclaren/Kilbriain Parish Register
Church of Ireland (i.e., Anglican or Church of England affiliate)

This Register is currently held at the archives of the Church of Ireland, the Representative Church Body Library, Dublin, where it is available for consultation.

Note: These early records are clearly a transcript of the original register/s. However, the style of handwriting is typical of that in the 1800s, not modern script, indicating that it must have been copied many years ago. The register begins in 1780, but there are very few records for some years, suggesting that these records are incomplete. In the earlier years baptisms, marriages and burials were interspersed—later there were three separate sections to the register.

I have been told that private baptisms tended to occur if a child was ill and there was concern for his or her life and no sponsors were in attendance. Those who survived were often later “received” into the church, at which time sponsors were named. However, in this register a substantial portion of the baptisms were private, so it seems unlikely that all of them were for ill children. No sponsors were listed for the private baptisms. So far I have only typed up the sponsors that were of interest to me! However, I do have the others in my notes, so please let me know if you are interested in any of them (but remember, no sponsors for private baptisms).

Then, as now, couples usually married in the bride’s home parish. Note there are a number of couples for whom we have only one child baptised. I am told this often indicates that this is the home of the wife, who would return to her parents’ home to deliver her first child. Later children would be born in the couple’s home, often the home of the husband’s family. Those for whom there is a marriage but no children must have lived in another parish.

These are not all of the records in the register, but include those for people whose surname indicates a possible relationship with known families in New Brunswick or Ontario. Individuals known to have settled in New Brunswick are marked *. There are others that I suspect did so and I would appreciate any feedback from any of you on that—please send such info and any comments to the List, rather than to me personally. Unfortunately, some of the information I have on these families is in my files back in Canada.

Sometimes people’s names were spelled one way in one entry, another way in another entry. Where that happened I have indicated both alternatives with a slash between them. Some of the townlands are not spelled correctly by modern spellings. If I know that to be the case I have added the current spelling (from the website: www.seanruad.com) in [square] brackets. Anything in square brackets is my input—not from the register itself. And finally, if a question mark in square brackets follows a word[?], it means the handwriting was difficult to read and I may not have transcribed it correctly.

[“Thomas Knowles (1799-1885) petitioned for 200 acres, lot fifteen, for his father William, and for 300 acres, lot fourteen, for himself. Thomas received lot fourteen in 1831, and a brother William, received lot fifteen in 1831.

“In 1837, Hannah Knowles, widow of the late William Knowles petitioned for the eastern third part of lot seventeen.

“This lot was cleared and improved by William and has been occupied by them for a number of years. This lot was finally granted to William Miller in 1840.

“William Knowles (1783-1881) married Elizabeth Harley (1786-1876). Their children were John and Richard.

“Thomas Knowles (1799-1885) married Ann Hillock. Their children were William, Robert, Richard, George, Alexander, John, Hannah, Clara and Cora. William went west [to Coshocton OH?] in 1842 where he was joined later by Alexander and Cora.” (*Pioneer Settlers of the Bay Chaleur*, p. 16)

“Richard Knowles born 1789 petitioned for his land in 1819. He received 100 acres lot twenty-six in 1825. Richard did not stay here, he moved to Ohio in 1845.” (*Pioneer Settlers of the Bay Chaleur*, p. 17)]
