To be equally divided among my surviving heirs. Together with all my stock of every kind — — — Peter gets his two hundred dollars of it.

I do hereby revoke all other wills and testaments made by me, and do constitute and appoint my beloved wife Sarah, Edward Chambers, Humphrey Gamali and Melcom Wasing executors to this my last will & testament.
