I am glad you made such good grades

I know it is hard for you to milk
but you can rest when I come home.

They look for Walter back anytime he
said he would be gone 3 weeks.
it has been so dark & gloomy. sorry
since I came hope it has not rained
up there. I expect Walter is getting
nearly done sowing.

I thought it was. I wasn't very close
to her but I thought it was her.
it was almost sundown when
I got here.
