that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has
blessed me I therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and
annulling all others hitherto made by me

Item first I direct and desire that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who
gave it as I hope for Eternal Salvation through the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
whose Religion I have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed for forty years
Item second I direct and desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my
executors hereinafter named

Item third I give and devise to my beloved wife Charlotte Starr with whom I have
lived in the strictest quiet and love for forty few years all of my Property both real
and personal during her natural lifetime

Item fourth I desire that if my Executors shoula think proper to dispose of any of my property they may do so at any time they think best in a private sale or any other way they may think proper or best

Item fifth I desire that all of the money that is owing to me in Notes and accounts that they shall be equally divided between my legatees I further desire that at the death of my wife that all of my Estate both real and personal shall be equally divided among my legatees or at any time my wife may see proper to divide of my Estate between Mary Gray & Frances C Ogletree Children now living & Silas Starr & John H Starr & Hilard M Starr & Charlotte P Simmons & William D Starr & Martha A Ogletree surviving Children

Item sixth I desire that my Executors employ some suitable person to wall in the grave of Alatha Jarot & Frances C Ogletree & Martha A Ogletree for which they may pay fifty Dollars out of my Estate if needed

Item seventh I Constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Charlotte Executrix and my beloved Son John H Starr & Hilard M Starr Executors to this my last will and Testament this 24th June 1851
