State of Georgia This Inventory made the fifteenth of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and hundred & fourteeen and on the thirty ninth year of the independence of the united states of America between Henry Stark of the County of Wilkes and state aforesaid of the first part and Asa Starr and Samuel Stark of Wilkes County & state aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Stark for & in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars lawful money of the said state to him in his well & truly paid by the said Asa and Samuel Stark at before the sealing Delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Asa Stark and Samuel Stark their heirs & assigns All that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred & fifty acres more or less situated in the County of Wilkes and state aforesaid and bounded as follows beginning at a black Gum and running North  $65^{\circ}$  West 61 Chains to a pine then west  $25^{\circ} W$  68 Chains to an oak an Lawson tree then along the line of  $65^{\circ} E$  112 to a white oak on the Greensborough road then to a Diron said road to the beginning B-Gum together with all and singular the rights members and appertinances therof whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and thereunto belonging Rents & issues are & property thereto of every part thereof to have & to hold the said tract of land & all & singular the premises and appertinances thereto belonging aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said Asa Stark and Samuel Stark their heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said Asa and Samuel Stark to them and assigns and the said Henry Stark

bring the tract of Land & premises aforesaid  
& every part thereof unto the said <sup>the</sup> Henry Stark and  
James Stark their heirs & assigns against him &  
said Henry Stark his heirs and all and every person  
or persons whatsoever shall & will receive  
deposited by these presents for injury whereof the said
