Pendleton District } Know all men by these presents that I **Thomas Orr** of the District of Pendleton and State of South Carolina and of **County Armagh in Ireland** am held and firmly Indebted to **Andrew Warnock Senr John Dickson and Thomas Johnston** all of the District of Pendleton and State of South Carolina and **administrators to the Estate of William Orr** late of the District and State aforesaid, **Merchant deceased** in the sum of two thousand dollars which payment well and truly to be made unto the said Andrew Warnock, Senr., John Dickson & Thomas Johnston their heirs or assigns. I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators or assigns in **Witness whereof** I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this **sixteenth day of July** in the year of our Lord **one thousand eight hundred and five** and the thirtieth year of the Independence of the united States of America. The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Orr shall keep the above named Andrew Warnock Senr, John Dickson & Thomas Johnston and their heirs indemnify from the heirs of the above named **William Orr** deceased and more particularly from all who may claim by Heirship or in Virtue of a certain **Mary fethight** other [several words are smeared] to the aforesaid William Orr Deceased and from every other person or persons Lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part of the Estate or property belonging to the said William Orr deceased and also if the aforesaid Thomas Orr shall as a further indemnification give to the said Warnock, Dickson & Johnston another Bond with Sufficient Surety for the same sum and for the same purpose of this at any time when required by the aforesaid administrators or by any two of them then and in Those cases the above Obligation shall be entirely void. Other wise to remain in full force. Signed Sealed and delivered in presents of

Orr shall keep the above named Warrick Dickson & Thomas Johnston and their heirs
in peace from the fruits of the above named Estate in law and equity and more particularly from all who may
claim by Her Majesty or inheritance of a certain share of the same or other ways or means and set off to the above
named Orr because and from every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part
of the Estate or property belonging to the said William Orr deceased and also if the aforesaid Thomas Orr shall as
aforesaid indemnification give to the said Warrick Dickson & Johnston and their heirs with sufficient security
the same sum and for the same purpose of this at any time when required by the aforesaid Administrators or
any two of them then and in those cases the above Obligation shall be entirely void. Other wise to remain
in force. Signed sealed and delivered in presence of
