FORKS OF ELKHORN CHURCH

The Sneed Family: The Sneeds descend from Benjamin Sneed of Caroline county, Virginia, who died in Virginia. His widow, Mary (Colman?) Sneed, who m. second Thomas Ayers (see Ayers) came to Kentucky with her children: 1. Susan m. Carter Blanton; 2. Jane m. Rev. M. Rev. John Scott; 3. Samuel Coleman m. Polly Daniel, Caroline County, Virginia, 1797. They came to Franklin, where they lived for a few years before settling in a part of Gallatin which was afterwards in Owen. He died about 1823, leaving his wife and (a) Fanny (m. James Chrisman, of Owen); (b) Jane m. James Snape, Gallatin 1818 (c) Betsey m. Francis More, Owen 1824; (d); William (m. Nancy Munday?); (e) James; Susan. 4. Mary m. Thomas Daniel; 5. Elizabeth m. Samuel Sale, and they settled in the section of Mercer that is now Anderson. Their children were: Stephen, James, Ira, Samuel, William D., Lucy Mary, Nancy. Nancy m. John Elliston and they went to Gallatin. Their children were : Maria Garvey, Elizabeth Sale, Polly, Susan Knox, James T, Ben S., Catherine Scrugges, Robert M.. p.236

Probably related to those families was John Sneed (1755 - 1855). [He was the son of Benjamin, born 1721, who came to Danville (KY) about 1816 and died 1819] He died a hundred years later at the home of his son, Alexander, in Danville. He m. Sally Johnson and they came to Mercer.Co. He is recorded as having ten children, some of whom were: Cynthia Mims, b. 1784, m. Joseph Wilson, Mercer 1810; 2, Alexander, b. 1786 (father of Sally, who m. Senator G.G. Vest of Missouri, 1854?) 3. John H., b. 1792; 4. Matilda m. William Hughes; 5, Polly m. Thomas Harrison, Mercer 1811. p.236/7.

His name appears on the muster roll covering the period from Feb 2nd 1776 to May 3rd 1777, which shows he enlisted Feb. 4th, year not shown, which now bears the remark "Dec. 28 - Dec. 76.

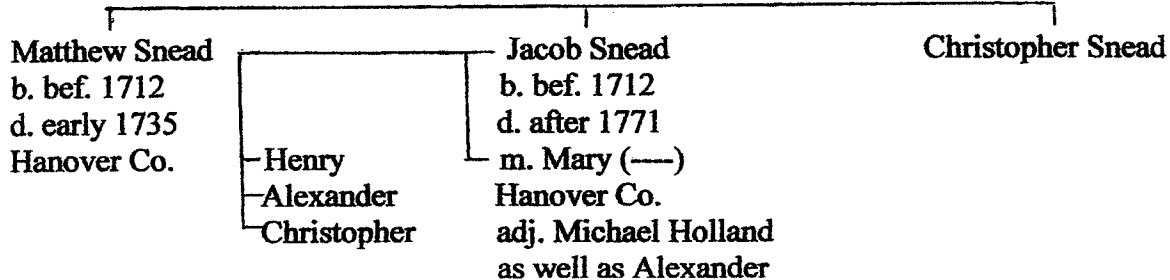

WILL OF WILLIAM SNEED OF HENRICO COUNTY:

To son Robert Sneed, the 100 acres I live on, a mare & items,
To my daughter Lucy Sneed, items
To my daughter, Mary Sneed, items
To my daughter Martha Sneed, items
To my wife Katherine Sneed, the rest of my estate for life, and then equally to my children.
Executors: wife and son Robert. Dated 5 Feb. 1777
Wit: Jonathan Bridgewater, Annis Bridgewater, William Bridgewater
Recorded 2 June 1783 with Barrett Price security. TVF, vol 6, , no. 2, p.98
[Hatcher names daus. Catherine b. 1748, Martha b. 1750, and Robert b. 1750]
