Did Garfoot ever give a Certificate to Hundlet

His Hundlet yr Indenture or Garfoot

Was not you Examined upon Oath concerning your Settlement before a Justice of Peace

Where is your Quarr Sessions held next for Leeds in what riding is it

Was your Master at Staley a Certificate man

When & where was you married ? What Children?

How old the Youngest

What Goods & Effects have you

What is yr rent Did you ever pay any Parish taxes

How came you to be removed after so long a Settlement undistrbd was you actually chargeable How much pay have you ver rec
