No enlargement of joints but conditions of tenderness of shoulder and minor the muscular systems. Loss of muscular tone loose and flabby.*

It must be borne in mind that the duty of the Surgeon is to give an opinion as to the proportionate degree of disability, as a total, &c., through the grades, without any regard to dollars and cents, and to make such a full particular description as will afford to this Office the ground for intelligent opinion and action in rating.

From the existing condition and the history of this claimant, as stated by himself, it is, in our judgment, _____ probable that the disability was incurred in the service as he claims, and that it has not been prolonged or aggravated by vicious habits. He is, in our opinion, entitled to a *6-10* rating for the disability caused by *Diarrhoea, Piles and results,* for that caused by *Rheumatism*, and _____ caused by _____
